Attendance Matters from Ms. Nason

We have taken on another initiative here at Center School! We welcome Elizabeth Nyser, Mental Health Specialist, who is working with me to support students to address truancy and attendance issues.

Nationally, an estimated 5-7 million students are chronically absent each year, eroding students' performance as early as kindergarten. By third grade, chronically absent students are less likely to read on grade level (www.attendanceworks.org).

Our attendance committee meets once a month. We have begun sending letters to remind families of the importance of school attendance, including how many days your child has missed. Don't be alarmed if you receive an attendance letter in the mail; we are always looking for ways to improve our school-family partnership. Please let us know if you are having challenges getting your child to school; we can provide strategies, resources and support for barriers such as anxiety, transportation, schedules, and feeling connected at school. New Kindergarten Eligibility Entry Date

Children entering kindergarten must turn 5 years old on or before September 1, 2024 to be eligible for kindergarten in the 2024-2025 school year. This is a change from the previous kindergarten cutoff date of January 1, 2025. Based on the new Connecticut legislation, if your child's 5th birthday falls on September 2, 2024 through August 31, 2025, your child will enter kindergarten in the 2025-2026 school year.



★★ Each child must select at least three of the five components on their tray to make a meal, including a fruit or vegetable. Children MUST select a fruit or a vegetable with their lunch every day. Without a vegetable or fruit, students will be charged the a la carte price instead of the meal price. For instance, a protein choice, a grain choice and a vegetable would make a complete meal. ★★

Every student needs to be prepared to select at least one fruit or one vegetable with their breakfast and lunch every day.
